

Welcome to our consultation platform. To ensure constructive, transparent and respectful exchanges, each contributor agrees to uphold the following principles:

1. Respect and Kindness

The platform is a space for debate and ideas. We encourage diversity of viewpoints, provided they are expressed in a civil manner:

- **Courtesy:** Personal attacks, insults, aggressive or provocative language are prohibited.
- **Tolerance:** No content of a discriminatory, racist, sexist, homophobic or hate-inciting nature will be tolerated.
- **Argumentation:** Favour facts and sharing experiences rather than value judgements.

2. Anonymity and Privacy Protection

In order to guarantee the safety of all participants and the neutrality of exchanges, contributions must comply with strict confidentiality rules:

- **Prohibition of identification:** It is strictly forbidden to name individuals or to provide details enabling their indirect identification.
- **Protection of personal data:** Never publish your personal contact details (phone number, email address, postal address) or those of third parties within your contributions.
- **Neutrality:** Any contribution aimed at personally targeting an individual will be automatically moderated.

3. Quality and Relevance of Exchanges

To ensure your ideas are impactful, make sure they are clear and useful to the community:

- **Topic of the consultation:** Your contributions must be directly related to the proposed theme.
- **Original content:** Avoid mass copy-paste or excessive repetitions (spam).
- **Non-commercial:** The platform may not be used for promotional, advertising or electoral purposes.

4. Moderation Process

The moderation team reserves the right to:

1. **Hide** any message that does not comply with the rules above.
2. **Edit** a contribution to remove only identifying elements (proper names) in order to preserve the general idea, where technically possible.
3. **Ban** a user in the event of serious or repeated breaches of this charter.

5. Platform Commitment

In return, we commit to:

- Taking note of every contribution.
- Faithfully and transparently reporting the results of the consultation.
- Ensuring the security of your login data in accordance with the «loi sur la protection des données (LPD)».
